

National Conference on Student Activities (NCSA)

The National Conference on Student Activities has been bringing together Administrators, Advisors, Allies and Advocates of Student Activities for 50 years. Many of our attendees at this three-day conference are Student Council or Student Government Advisors. In addition to top notch keynote speakers there are many workshops in which outstanding materials and programs are presented, opportunities for lively exchange about important topics of choice in the field of Student Activities and Table Talks sessions in which attendees can share and gain numerous ideas. Attendees come away inspired with a newly loaded toolbox of great ideas and strategies to try out when returning to their own schools!



National Activity Advisors Clinic (NAAC)

NA4SA has an ongoing focus on supporting advisors of all student activity groups. A key to effective advising is having a "toolbox" stocked with helpful skills, activity ideas and resources that makes working with developing student leaders less stressful and more enjoyable. The **National Activity Advisors Clinic** is a low cost (\$35) virtual event designed to facilitate participation from the across the country. The NAAC is a one-day (typically Saturday) event held in August. The agenda runs from 11:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. (EDT). Attending this clinic is a great way for advisors to start their school year. NAAC 2024 will provide 5 hours of hands-on training, interactive, practical, inspirational, and ready to use advising tools that will set the stage for a great new year!




NA4SA Seminar Series

The Seminar Series offers presentations, lively discussions, and idea sharing on topics of interest to the advocates, advisors, administrators, and allies of Student Activities. These FREE seminars are virtual events that begin at 7:00 Eastern Time and typically last from 60 to 90 minutes. Pre-registration is required to share the Zoom link and video.

NA4SA Academy

As NA4SA looks ahead to our next 50 years, programs have been discussed to enhance the field of student activities beyond the NCSA, NAAC, and the Seminar Series. Designing a structured professional development program specifically for activity advisors and professionals has been focus of our organization under the current Strategic Plan. Each component of the NA4SA Academy is virtual in nature to allow participants to move through the curriculum based on their schedules and are low cost. The intent is to make the Academy affordable and accessible for all advisors.



Foundations for Advisors is specifically designed for activity advisors in their first or second year on the job. In addition to receiving valuable professional development programming around student activities each month, advisors in this program receive check-ins from an extensive mentor network to provide individualized assistance and support. In Level II of the NA4SA Academy, participants can take advantage of individualized pathways specifically designed for activity advisors, leadership teachers, and summer workshop/camp staff members. Individuals may elect to enroll in one, two, or all three of the Level II pathways, depending on their needs and their roles.

The entire **NA4SA Academy** program is designed to provide valuable training and information for activity advisors, leadership class teachers, and summer leadership camp & workshop staff. We encourage all Student Activity Professional to advantage of this unique opportunity for learning and sharing information and resources with one another to enhance their work.

Resource Library

A key feature of participating in NA4SA is access to the digital Resource Library. Since its inception over 50 years ago, the sharing of ideas, resources and activities among activity advisors has been a cornerstone of our organization.

Several hundred pages of curated reference materials may be found in eighteen different folders under the Advisor Resources tab. Handouts from past conferences going back to 2016 are archived under the Workshop Handouts tab. Sample Leadership Class outlines, grading criteria and curriculum ideas can be found under the Leadership Class Materials, and recordings of previous NA4SA Seminars on various topics may be found under the Virtual Meeting tab.
